SATRO Research Placements is a programme running since 1999, SATRO matches Year 12 A-Level (or Level 3 Equivalent) students with companies and research organisations in the summer to undertake a short research project. This should be of benefit to both the organisation and the student as part of a real-world aspect of the work you do. Examples from last year include:

- Explore perceptions and awareness of hydrogen refueling stations as society looks to adopt hydrogen vehicles
- For a national charity research how to create effective working practices with stakeholders and partnership opportunities
- Research current modern methods of construction systems .

Your Role

to provide a research project title, guide student(s) in their research and give feedback on their final work. We would like all students to visit your place of work during the project if possible.

Students

will work with you virtually to prepare a research project based on a topic of interest. We ask you to meet them virtually at the launch, at least twice during the programme and also at the final presentation.

Projects

will be in the form of a report, video, poster, presentation or combination and the students will present back to you, and your staff, at the end of the programme. A project can involve a team of students or individual research.

Planning

we ask each student to commit a period of time over at least 2 weeks, during the period 1st July – 23rd August. Final dates to be agreed between parties and to suit your organisation, this can be full or part time.

Outcomes

research projects offer meaningful input to a topic. Students submit for Gold CREST Awards, use it as evidence in UCAS entries, engage in further outreach. SATRO showcases at our RWP celebration in the Autumn.
