SATRO CONSTRUCTIONFEST

Following the success of last year's event, we will be holding our second **SATRO Constructionfest** on **30th November 2023**; thank you to Ringway who are once again sponsoring this event.

SATRO has run a programme of mobile vocational construction teaching since 2006. Today we have eight tutors with vans who deliver to over 450 students across Surrey, Berkshire, Hampshire, West London Boroughs and Sussex.

Students study either a BTEC Level 1 Introductory 1-year Award or 2-year Certificate level or our SATRO Introduction to Construction Skills Award. We deliver carpentry, plumbing, electrical skills to students in mainstream, alternative provision, pupil referral units and special needs schools.

The event is for our first-year students (aged 14-18) so they can meet industry and learn more about the pathways into employment or further studies.

The day will have 3 main activities:

- **company stands** with 10 min hands-on activities;
- pathway workshops on traineeships, apprenticeships, college studies and becoming business ready,
- careers speed networking with companies and trades/sub-contractors.
