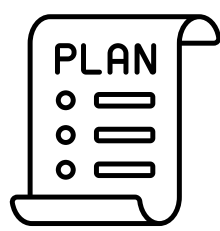
The day is fully facilitated by SATRO and is suitable for anyone with an experience of work, whatever your role or industry.

How The Day Works...

The students are put into teams and then complete the following tasks



Students assign roles to themselves and come up with a company name
VOLUNTEERS can support this by asking students why they chose the role. They can talk about the skills they have and what they are hoping to learn.



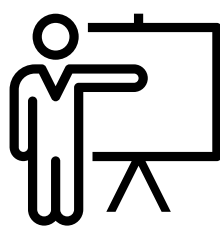
Students design their prototype, initially on paper before making it using the materials provided.
VOLUNTEERS can support by asking students who their target market is and what makes their design unique.



Students then make their first prototype.
VOLUNTEERS will then be assigned the role of negotiator or shop keeper. Negotiators will decide on a price for the team to produce more copies of their prototype set criteria such as deadlines and quality requirements.



Students must manage their cashflow to ensure they can purchase additional supplies. VOLUNTEERS will run the shop and ensure that students have enough money to make purchases.



Students will produce a presentation.
VOLUNTEERS will listen to the presentation, ask questions and give feedback and decide on the best presentation.
