## Volunteering

Volunteers are key to engaging and inspiring the children. We are keen for you to share your science knowledge and support students by asking questions to help them to think about their decisions and promote curiosity. The workshop is fully facilitated by SATRO and is suitable for anyone with an experience of Policing, Forensics, Science (e.g. Biology) or an interest in wildlife.

## **How The Day Works...**

The children will be aged 5 - 7 years old and split into groups. The group rotates round the activities spending 15-20 minutes at each "laboratory". VOLUNTEERS choose their preferred station based on their own interests/experience. The VOLUNTEERS are asked to introduce each activity to their group and help the children complete their evidence sheets.



Shoe and pawprint analysis – who's been inside the Three Bear's cottage?



Hair and fur analysis – who does the hair found in the Three Bear's cottage belong to?



Bite mark analysis – who could have left teeth marks in Baby Bear's spoon?



Chair reconstruction - which suspect could have broken Baby Bear's chair?



We also offer an opportunity for VOLUNTEERS to share their own experiences and give a brief overview of their own jobs (tailored to the age group)
